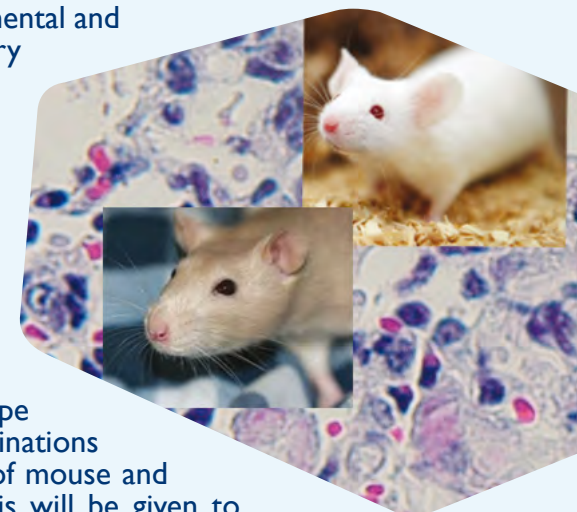
Pathology of Laboratory Animals in Biomedical Research
