Postdoctoral fellowship in anatomic veterinary pathology

The Department of Veterinary Sciences at the University of Turin (UNITO) invites applications for a postdoctoral fellowship in anatomic veterinary pathology at the rank of Assistant Professor. The successful candidate will join an established and collegial pathology team comprising seven anatomic pathologists, two biologists, and a group of young fellows.

We are seeking a veterinary diagnostician to work at the Veterinary Anatomic Pathology Diagnostic Laboratory (VAPDL). The responsibilities of the position include performing gross and histologic examinations on a variety of species and diagnosing diseases with a special focus on livestock. Other duties include handling biopsies and necropsies, engaging with the lab's quality system, pursuing professional development, and contributing to continuous laboratory improvement. There are also opportunities for collaborative research, case-based scholarship, and participation in department teaching.

The VAPDL is equipped with excellent research support facilities, including a histological lab, an automatic immunostainer, a digital PCR machine, and other instruments for cellular and biological research purposes. Requirements for this position include a DVM degree, appropriate training in veterinary pathology, and achievement of (or eligibility for) certification by the European or American College of Veterinary Pathologists. A PhD degree is also required, along with a minimum of 10 peer-reviewed publications. Salary will be commensurate with experience. While knowledge of the Italian language is not initially required, as this position is renewable annually, we recommend at least an elementary knowledge of Italian as a minimum.

Applications will be accepted until a suitable candidate has been identified.
